

Vigilant Shutdown & Reboot Procedure

Preface

This document explains how to properly shut down the Vigilant monitor or reboot it.

Warning: Improper shutdown of the monitor can corrupt the database, which can require returning the monitor for repair.

Examples of improper shutdown are below:

- 1. Flipping the toggle switch off before shutting the unit down from the web-interface
- 2. Removing power from the 24V supply before shutting the unit down from the web-interface

Shutdown Procedure

1. Login to the monitor and open the Settings page



2. On the Settings page, click the **Actions** button


3. On the Actions page, click the **Shutdown** button

4. On the Shutdown page, click the **Yes - Shutdown** button



5. Wait about 1 minute, then flip the power switch off, or remove the 24V input power source


Reboot Procedure

1. Login to the monitor and open the **Settings** page



2. On the Settings page, click the **Actions** button

3. On the Actions page, click the **Reboot** button


